



**Notice of Public Hearing
Proposal to Fix or Increase District
Fees, Rates, Tolls, Penalties, and Charges**

At a Public Meeting to be held at the times and place listed below, the Board of Directors of the South Adams County Water and Sanitation District acting for itself and by and through its South Adams County Water and Sanitation District Activity Enterprise (“Board”) will consider approving proposals for:

- a water rate increase up to 1.0%;
- a wastewater rate increase up to 1.0%;
- an increase in industrial pretreatment rates and fees up to 1.0%;
- an increase in new water and wastewater connection fees up to 10.0%;
- an increase in the Centralized Water Softening Fee from currently \$0.00 up to \$5.00 per ERU of service per month;
- a new fee for plan review of up to \$250.00 per hour of consulting time and costs (to be discussed and considered for approval at December meeting only); and
- other increases or new fees, rates, tolls, penalties, or charges as presented to the Board.

The Board will hold Public Hearings at the meetings to receive public comment regarding the proposed changes at its Regular November and December meetings. At the December Public Meeting, the Board will decide to approve, modify, or reject the proposals, and a decision may be deferred or continued to a future public meeting of the Board without additional Notice. The Public Meeting dates, time, and place are as follows:

The District reserves the right to increase the proposed increases and change the dates of the meetings; any revised Notices will be posted on the District’s website – www.sacwsd.org – and as required by law. The additional revenue is necessary to cover the costs of providing a safe and reliable source of water today and into the future, including escalating operating and capital costs, the costs of the District’s Pellet Softening Project (or “WSP”), and continued optimization of our treatment processes for PFAS compounds.
