



**Notice of Public Hearing  
Proposal to Fix or Increase District  
Fees, Rates, Tolls, Penalties, and Charges**

At a Public Meeting to be held at the times and place listed below, the Board of Directors of the South Adams County Water and Sanitation District acting for itself and by and through its South Adams County Water and Sanitation District Activity Enterprise (“Board”) will consider approving proposals for:

- Amending the District’s current Design and Construction Standards for Water and Wastewater Facilities, which amendments may include fixing or increasing District fees, rates, tolls, penalties, and charges connected with such standards; and
- increases in other District fees rates, tolls, penalties, or charges and/or new fees, rates, tolls, penalties, or charges as may be presented to the Board.

The Board will hold a Public Hearing at its April Regular Meeting to receive public comment regarding the proposed changes. Parties interested in commenting can do so in person at the meeting or may submit them in writing by 5:00 p.m. on April 11 to the District’s Distribution & Collection Manager, Jeff Coufal at [jcoufal@sacwsd.org](mailto:jcoufal@sacwsd.org). At the Board’s May meeting, the Board will decide to approve, modify, or reject the proposed amendments, and a decision may be deferred or continued to a future public meeting of the Board without additional Notice. A Public Hearing is not intended to be held at the May meeting – parties wishing to comment should do so at the April meeting. The Board meeting dates, time, and place are as follows:
